Critical traumatic injuries can be rapidly fatal, before the arrival of EMS and advanced care. Immediate action must be taken to preserve life, by those already at the scene.

Based on the 2018 guidelines established by the Committee for Tactical Emergency Casualty Care (C-TECC), this National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT) certified provider course will give you the knowledge, the skills, and the confidence to save your life, or the life of another, during an active trauma emergency.



You will learn and practice these life-saving skills:

- Mass Casualty Incident response, triage, and rapid care of critical penetrating, blunt, and blast trauma injuries
- Rapid trauma assessment
- Emergency moves and rescues
- Care for traumatic hypothermia and shock
- Tourniquets
- Hemostatics
- Pressure Bandages
- Occlusive Chest Seals
- Nasopharvngeal Airways
- Bag Valve Mask Ventilation
- Narcan
- Pulmonary management
- Prolonged care concepts
- Heat management

These skills were incorporated into the standard scope of practice for CA Law Enforcement in 2015, and are approved by CAPOST and CAEMSA. This comprehensive course provides an understanding of physiology, injury mechanics, and treatment protocols for traumatic injuries, through in-depth lecture and hands-on practice, drills, and scenarios. You will learn advanced treatment skills, why and how they are effective, what equipment is necessary, and why these skills are critical for everyone currently working in emergency response and public services.
